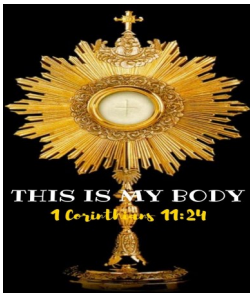
## HOSTING A COMMUNITY MASS AT YOUR HOME -

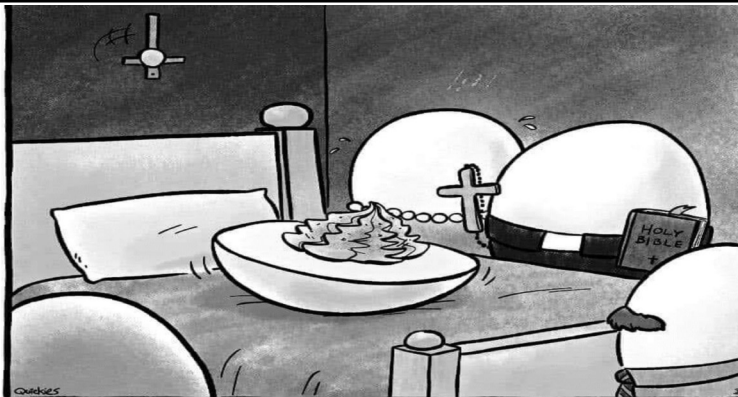
