A THOUGHT ABOUT THE GOSPEL:

In this weekend's Gospel, we encounter the story of Bartimaeus, the blind man who calls out to Jesus for mercy despite being rebuked by the crowd. His persistence and faith move Jesus to heal him, restoring not only his sight but also his dignity. This passage reminds us that no matter how overlooked or dismissed we may feel, God hears our cries and invites us to encounter Him in faith. As Catholics, Bartimaeus' story encourages us to trust in God's mercy, to be persistent in prayer, and to recognize Jesus as the source of healing in our lives. It also challenges us to see others with compassion and to be attentive to those around us that may feel unheard or marginalized, offering them the same love and mercy Christ extends to us.
