### PRAYING FOR OUR 2025 FIRST COMMUNION AND CONFIRMATION CANDIDATES

Last Sunday at the 10:30am Mass we celebrated the Rite of Commissioning with our young people who will be Confirmed in our Catholic faith on Sunday, April 6, 2025. In this Sacrament of Confirmation, they will receive the Holy Spirit and complete their full initiation into our Catholic Church. However, this word "complete" does not mean that they are done with their faith. What it means is that they are just beginning a fuller life in our faith, living it out, with fresh help of the Holy Spirit that they will receive from our bishop at their Confirmation.

Along with these Confirmation students, we are also blessed with 9 children who will be making their First Communion on Sunday, April 6, at our 10:30am Mass. For those of us who have received our First Communion, it is one of those days of faith that is imprinted in our faith memory. For myself, I remember taking pictures with my family outside of St. Elizabeth Catholic Church in Curdsville, KY. I can also remember walking in procession into the church with my hands folded and looking forward to receiving Jesus for the first time in Holy Communion. Finally, I can remember the party that my parents had at our home, complete with cake and all the trimmings.

As our Confirmation and First Communion candidates prepare for receiving these sacraments this year, I would ask that we surround them with our prayers.
