The Feast of the Immaculate Conception: December 8th falls on Sunday this year, consequently the Feast of the Immaculate Conception is transferred to Monday December 9th. Initially this was not a Holy Day of Obligation. An inquiry was made to Rome and Rome returned with a decision that in this case the Holy Day Obligation cannot be abrogated. Consequently, The Feast of the Immac ulate Conception is transferred to the December 9th and IS A HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION. Please remember that if you celebrate a Sunday evening Mass on December 8th that mass must be for the 2nd Sunday of Advent. Also, keep in mind the Holy Day Obligation is for 2 masses so in some cases, even though the readings may be the same, a person could count the Sunday evening mass for their Holy Day Obligation. For instance, if some one participated in the 8:00 am mass on Sunday, and then the 5:00 pm mass on Sunday evening (both masses for the 2nd Sunday of Advent), that person would be deemed as fulfilling both their Sunday obligation and their Holy Day obligation.

YOUTH MINISTRY AT PRECIOUS BLOOD PARISH Throughout the years, ministering to the youth of our church has had a strong presence here at Precious Blood Parish. It began with our parish school that opened its doors on September 6, 1960 with 244 students and closed in the early 90's. It continued both during and after the time of our school with caring adults who wanted to show our youth the love of Christ through sharing that love with their young hearts. This care for our youth was also present in our weekly Wednesday evening Faith Formation program that this year has 40 children, as well as our Sacramental Prep for First Communion and our Confirmation students. I am certain that over the years this care for our youth has seen its ups and downs, but that care for our youth has always been our heart's desire. With this bulletin I am happy to announce the formation of a new and revitalized effort to minister to our young people with the help of the Youth Core Team. This Youth Core Team is made up of both adults and high school youth. It will serve both those in middle school, high school and, we hope, young adults who are in college. Serving on this Core Team are the following: Haley Davis, Luke Dickens, Jonathon Brown, Fr. Our Core Team has been meeting of ten to form, plan and, most importantly, to pray for our youth. Through all of this we are happy to also share with you that we will be launching our first youth event in early January of 2025 that will focus on a New Year/New Youth. Begins Sunday December 1, and ends with Christmas, December 25.

In a world where people are feasting on many things to fill their hungry hearts, we at Precious Blood want to help us all to feast on Jesus. This Advent our preaching will focus on the steps we can take to Feed our Hungry Hearts with the real life of Jesus, the true gift of Christmas and beyond.

FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT – DEC 1: HOPE FOR HUNGRY HEARTS - Dcn. Ken will speak about how Advent is a season of hopeful anticipation, preparing us to recognize God's presence amid life's uncertainties and anxieties.

SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT - DEC 8: PEACE FOR HUNGRY HEARTS - Fr. Carl will speak about how John the Baptist's call to "prepare the way" invites us to seek a peace that is rooted in repentance and reconciliation with God and others.

• Please join us for adoration to follow the 10:30 am Mass, Eucharistic Procession though the community starting at 1:30 pm, with parish members going out two by two to check on our neighbors, and wrapping up back at the church for prayer and BENEDICTION.

THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT – DEC 15: JOY FOR HUNGRY HEARTS - Dcn. Jay will share how Gaudete Sunday invites us to rejoice because the Lord is near and that our joy is found in generosity and service to others.

FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT – DEC 22: LOVE FOR HUNGRY HEARTS - Fr. Carl will show how Mary's visitation to Elizabeth reveals the transforming power of love and the presence of Jesus that radiates through it.

THE NATIVITY – DEC 24 & 25: THE FULFILLMENT OF OUR ADVENT LONGING - Fr. Carl will wrap up the preaching series by reflecting on how Jesus himself is the answer to our every longing and the fulfillment of all our hunger.
