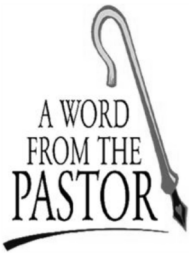

Lone Traveler: An incident is said about a visitor, when he came to the River Mississippi. He had to go across the river, but found that there was no bridge. Fortunately, it was winter time, and the great river was completely sheeted over with ice. But the visitor was afraid to walk over the ice, not knowing its thickness. Finally, with immense caution and fear, he began to creep on his hands and knees..... over the sheeted ice... constantly fearing, whether, the ice would be able to hold him up or whether it would crack at any time. He managed to get half-way through, when suddenly, he heard singing from behind. Cautiously, he turned around and was shocked to see the sight: Another traveler - a native of the land - was coming behind him.. Few Lists Every Catholic Should Be Familiar With: The 3 Theological Virtues: Faith, Hope, and Charity. **The 4 Cardinal Virtues:** Prudence, Justice, Fortitude and Temperance. **The 7 Capital Sins:** Pride, Greed, Lust, Anger, Gluttony, Envy and Sloth. **The 6 Sins Against the Holy Spirit:** Presumption, Despair, Resisting the known truth, Envy of another's spiritual good, Obstinacy in sin and Final impenitence. **Conditions for Mortal Sin:** Grave matter, Full knowledge and Deliberate consent. **The 6 Precepts of the Church (The Duties of a Catholic):** To go to Mass and refrain from servile work on Sundays and holy days, To go to Confession at least once a year, To receive the Eucharist at least once a year, To observe the days of fasting and abstinence, To help to provide for the needs of the Church according to one's abilities and station in life and To obey the marriage laws of the Church. **The 4 Pillars of the Catholic Faith:** The Apostles Creed, The Seven Sacraments, The Ten Commandments and The Lord's Prayer. **The 3 Pillars of the Church's Authority:** Sacred Scripture, Sacred Tradition and Living Magisterium. **The 3 Parts of the Church:** The Church Militant (Christians on Earth), The Church Suffering (Christians in Purgatory) and The Church Triumphant (Christians in Heaven).
