Dear Parish Family,

This Sunday is December 8, and normally this day in our Church would be observed as The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of Mary, a Holy Day. However, this year the solemnity is being moved one day to Monday, December 9, because Sunday is the Second Sunday of Advent. In previous years, when December 8 fell on a Sunday and the solemnity was observed on Monday, the obligation to attend Mass did not transfer with the observance. This year will be different, based on guidance provided by the Dicastery for Legislative Texts in Vatican City, Rome, which moved the obligation to Monday. In simple terms what all this means is that our Bishop Medley has asked us to attend Mass on the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception and to observe it as a Holy Day of Obligation.

Mass here at Precious Blood will be on Monday, December 9, at Noon. I look forward to praying with you in a special way that day. I also want to invite you to come to our Eucharistic Adoration and Procession through our neighborhood that we are hosting here on Sunday, December 8. Along with this Eucharistic Procession, we will be going door to door through our neighborhood, checking on our neighbors and asking how we can pray for their household. Here is the Schedule of the afternoon.

- 10:30am The Eucharist will be Exposed at the Conclusion of Sunday Mass
- 11:30am Adoration will begin after the 10:30am Mass
- 1:30pm The Eucharistic Process and Rosary throughout our Neighborhood begins. Individuals who cannot process with us can remain in Church in prayer.
- 2:30pm Eucharistic Process will return to the Church for continued Adoration.
- 2:30pm Prayer Warriors will be sent out door to door in our neighborhood to check on our neighbors and to ask how we can pray for them here at Precious Blood.
- 3:30pm Prayer Warriors will return to Church and will pray aloud the prayers we have received.
- 3:50pm Conclude Adoration with Benediction
- 4pm Dismissal

What a joy it will be for us to take the Eucharistic Lord out of our Church and process Him throughout the streets of our neighborhood. Then what a joy it will be to follow up this process by being Missionary Disciples of the Eucharist as we go as Prayer Warriors, door-to-door throughout our local neighborhood, checking on our neighbors and inviting their prayer intentions. I hope you will come and join us for this Parish Eucharistic Missionary Event.

THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT – DEC 15: JOY FOR HUNGRY HEARTS - Dcn. Jay will share how Gaudete Sunday invites us to rejoice because the Lord is near and that our joy is found in generosity and service to others.

FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT – DEC 22: LOVE FOR HUNGRY HEARTS - Fr. Carl will show how Mary's visitation to Elizabeth reveals the transforming power of love and the presence of Jesus that radiates through it.

THE NATIVITY – DEC 24 & 25: THE FULFILLMENT OF OUR ADVENT LONGING - Fr. Carl will wrap up the preaching series by reflecting on how Jesus himself is the answer to our every longing and the fulfillment of all our hunger.
