Like many homes throughout our area our church and buildings here at Precious Blood Parish incurred substantial damage with the early morning hail storm on Saturday, March 22. The buildings that sustained damage were the Rectory, Church, Parish Office and Classrooms, Parish Hall, Burgoo Barn, and Storage Buildings.

We have been waiting for the insurance adjuster to come on site to survey the damage. However, we know that the roofs, fascia, 2 windows on the rectory, gutters, gutter guards, even our HVAC units took a beating.

We are fortunate to have a good insurance program and we know that there is a \$5,000 that we will need to pay. I think of the many people throughout our community and world who do not have insurance and have to figure out other means to care for their storm damage. 
