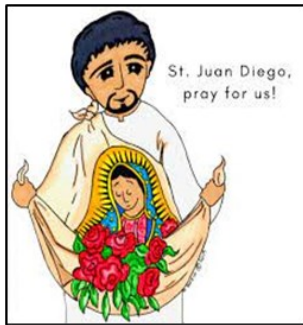

SAINT JUAN DIEGO'S NAME HAS BEEN ADDED TO OUR EUCHARISTIC PRAYER



You may have noticed that Fr. Carl has added the name of St. Juan Diego to the intercessory portion of the Eucharistic Prayer. The reason why is because St. Juan Diego is the patron saint of the southern route of Eucharistic Pilgrims who at this time are walking to the Eucharistic Congress. There are 10 pilgrims walking in this Eucharistic Procession route. They began their journey from Brownsville TX on the Feast of Pentecost and will end it around July 17 in Indianapolis IN at the Eucharistic Congress. A portion of this Eucharistic Pilgrimage Route came through our Diocese and made stops in Russellville and Bowling Green from June 30 – July 3. You are welcome to join the pilgrimage

THE 2024 EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS IS HAPPENING THIS WEEK LET US PRAY FOR A TRUE REVIVAL OF THE EUCHARIST

The 2024 National Eucharistic Congress is taking place this week, July 17-21, in Indianapolis IN. I plan on being there with some 50,000 others from around the country. We will attend Mass, worship, talks, workshops, and more as we celebrate a revival of Christ's true presence in the Eucharist.

This revival of the Eucharist began three years ago as a spiritual call of our American Bishops, who saw a need to help us revive our belief that Jesus Christ is truly present in the Eucharist. This Eucharistic Congress is the first such event to be held in the U.S. in over 80 years. The first international Eucharistic Congress was held in Lille, France in 1881. It was organized in response to the decline of the Catholic Church in France following the French Revolution. Let us pray that this 2024 Eucharistic Congress will bring about a renewal in the US Church.

As a part of this Eucharistic Congress, four pilgrimages -- from north, south, east and west -- have been traveling with the Blessed Sacrament through the US since Pentecost Sunday. The southern route, called the St. Juan Diego route, made it's way into our Diocese of Owensboro June 30-July 3, and journeyed through Russellville, Auburn, Gasper River and Bowling Green. Such a pilgrimage of the Eucharist has never been done in the US, and all four routes are on their way to Indianapolis, arriving on the evening of July 16th.

Here at Precious Blood Parish, we are partaking in the Eucharistic Revival through our Summer Teaching Series on the Mass. We are using the work of Bishop Robert Barron, called "The Mass." This is a teaching series began last Wednesday, July 10th, and will continue for six consecutive Wednesday nights until August 14th. Each teaching will be held in our Parish Hall. I would invite you to come to our Wednesday night Mass at 6pm and then stay with us for the teaching on the Mass at 7pm. On our last evening together, we will have a potluck meal.

With all of the focus on the Eucharist, let us pray for a true revival and deepening of our belief that Jesus Christ is truly present in the Eucharist.
