- Community Building: Connect with others who share your faith journey.

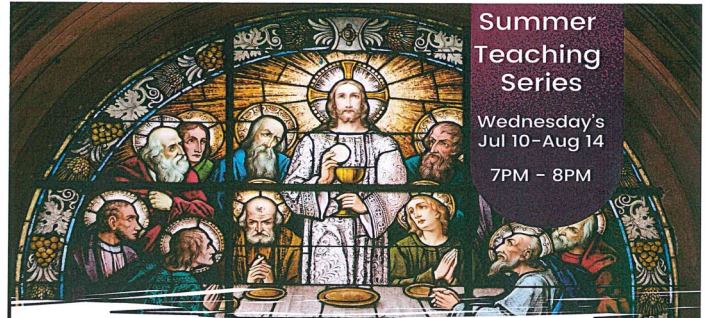
