



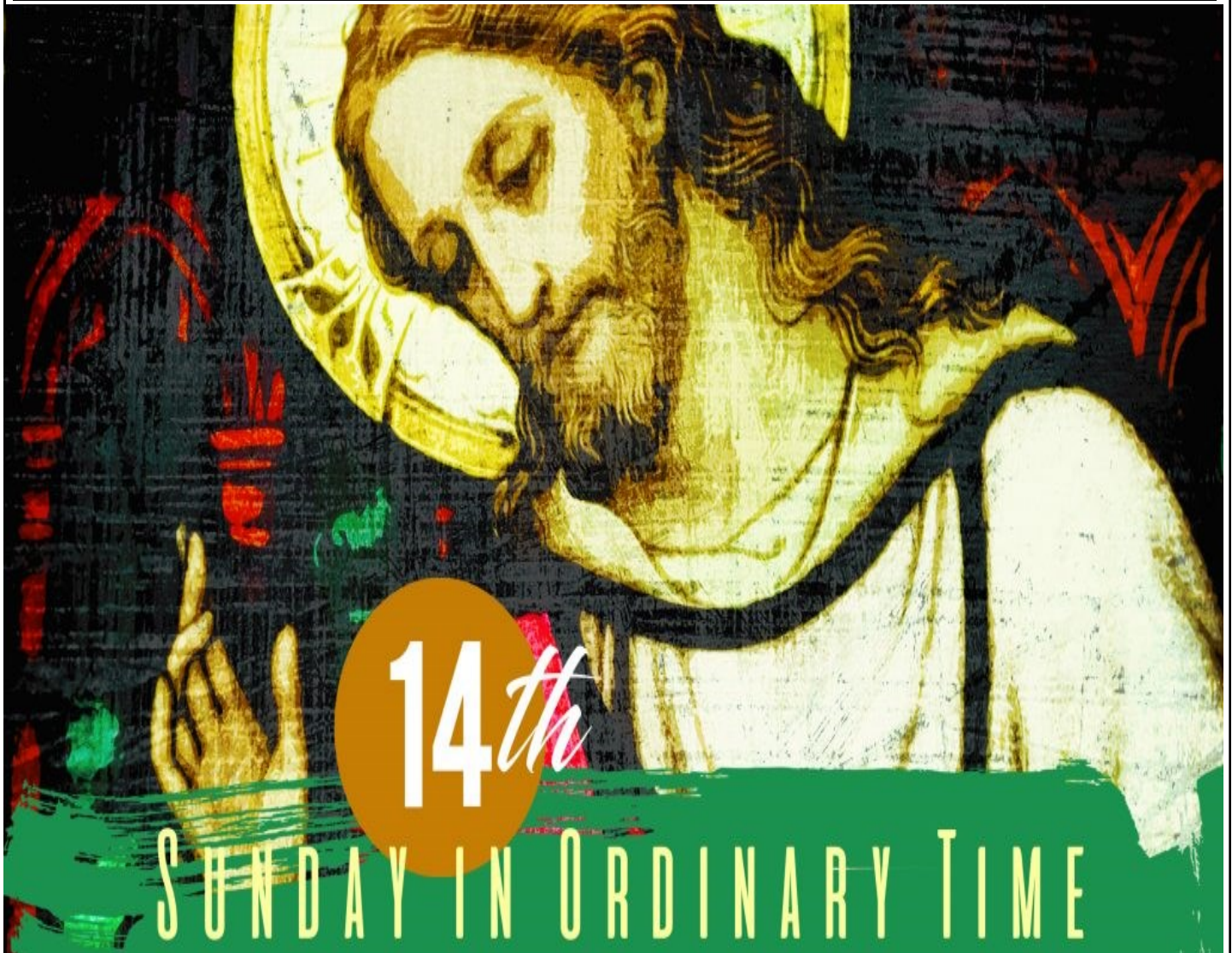

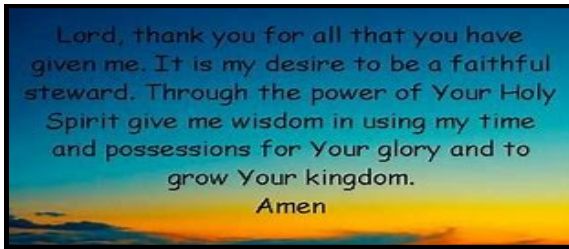

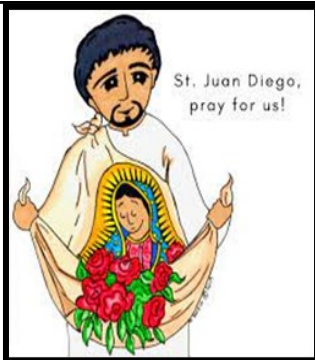

You may have noticed that Fr. Carl has added the name of St. Juan Diego to the intercessory portion of the Eucharistic Prayer. The reason why is because St. Juan Diego is the patron saint of the southern route of Eucharistic Pilgrims who at this time are walking to the Eucharistic Congress. There are 10 pilgrims walking in this Eucharistic Procession route. They began their journey from Brownsville TX on the Feast of Pentecost and will end it around July 17 Indianapolis IN at the Eucharistic Congress. SUGGESTION OF A BOOK TO READ

Every so often I come across a book that I have read that has been inspirational and helpful to me that I will pass along to you.

This week I want to pass along the suggestion for the book "The Shepherd Who Didn't Run" It is a story about the life, call to the priesthood, martyrdom, and road to sainthood of Fr. Stanley Rother, now Blessed Stanley Rother.

Here is a little about what you will read in the book. This piece about the book and his life was taken from the online Pauline Book Store ...

Fr. Stanley Rother was true to his word. He did not run. And was martyred at the age of 46.

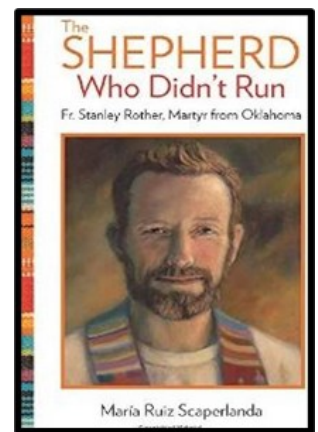
Fr. Stanley arrived in Guatemala in 1968, and immediately identified with his parishioners' simple, farming lifestyle. He learned their languages, prepared them for the Sacraments, and cared for their needs. Fr. Stanley, or "Padre Francisco" as he was called by his beloved Tz'utujil Indians, had found his heart's calling.

After nearly a decade, the violence of the Guatemalan civil war found its way into the peaceful village. Disappearances, killings, and danger became daily occurrences, but despite this unrest Fr. Stanley remained hard at work, building a farmer's co-op, a school, a hospital, and the first Catholic radio station, used for catechesis.

In early 1981, his name was on a death list, so he returned to Oklahoma and was warned not to return. But he could not abandon his people, so he went back, and made the ultimate sacrifice for his faith.

"Pray for us that we may be a sign of the love of Christ for our people," said Fr. Stanley, "that our presence among them will fortify them to endure these sufferings in preparation for the coming of the Kingdom."

The Diocese of Owensboro also has a relic of now Blessed Stanley Rother that I am working to bring here to our parish for our prayer and devotion.
