pastor's Corner

THE SOLEMNITY OF THE ASSUMPTION OF MARY, THURSDAY, AUGUST 15

This Thursday, August 15, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary into Heaven. This Solemnity is a Holy Day of Obligation. Masses will be celebrated here at Precious Blood on Wednesday, the Vigil is at 6pm & Thursday, the Day at 7am & 6pm

Some history about this Solemnity is that on November 1, 1950, Pope Pius XII defined as a truth revealed by God that the Immaculate Mother of God, Mary ever Virgin, when the course of her life one earth was finished, was taken up body and soul into heaven. This is where we define the dogma of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin.

Cardinal Newman teaches "It was surely fitting, it was becoming, that she should be taken up into heaven and not lie in the grave till Christ's second coming, one who had passed a life of sanctity and of miracles such as hers.

She died, then, because even our Lord and Savior died. But though she died as well as others, she died not as others die; for, through the merits of her Son, by whom she was what she was, by grace of Christ which in her had anticipated sin, which had filled her with light, which had purified her flesh from all defilement, she had been saved from disease and malady, and all that weakens and decays the bodily frame."

Jesus and Mary both passed through the gate of death into heaven. In her own way, Mary was crucified with Jesus. She patiently stayed on earth, after His Ascension, so log as God wiled.

Today, from her place in heaven she still abides invisibly for us, ever our refuge, our comfort, our hope, Through the Communion of the Saints, of which she is the Queen, we share in the joy and the glory of her Assumption.

This week make a stop at our own Marian Grotto, located just outside the front doors of our Church, next to the ball field. There, let us pray that Mary the Queen of Heaven intercede for us to the Father of our Lord, Jesus Christ.


