



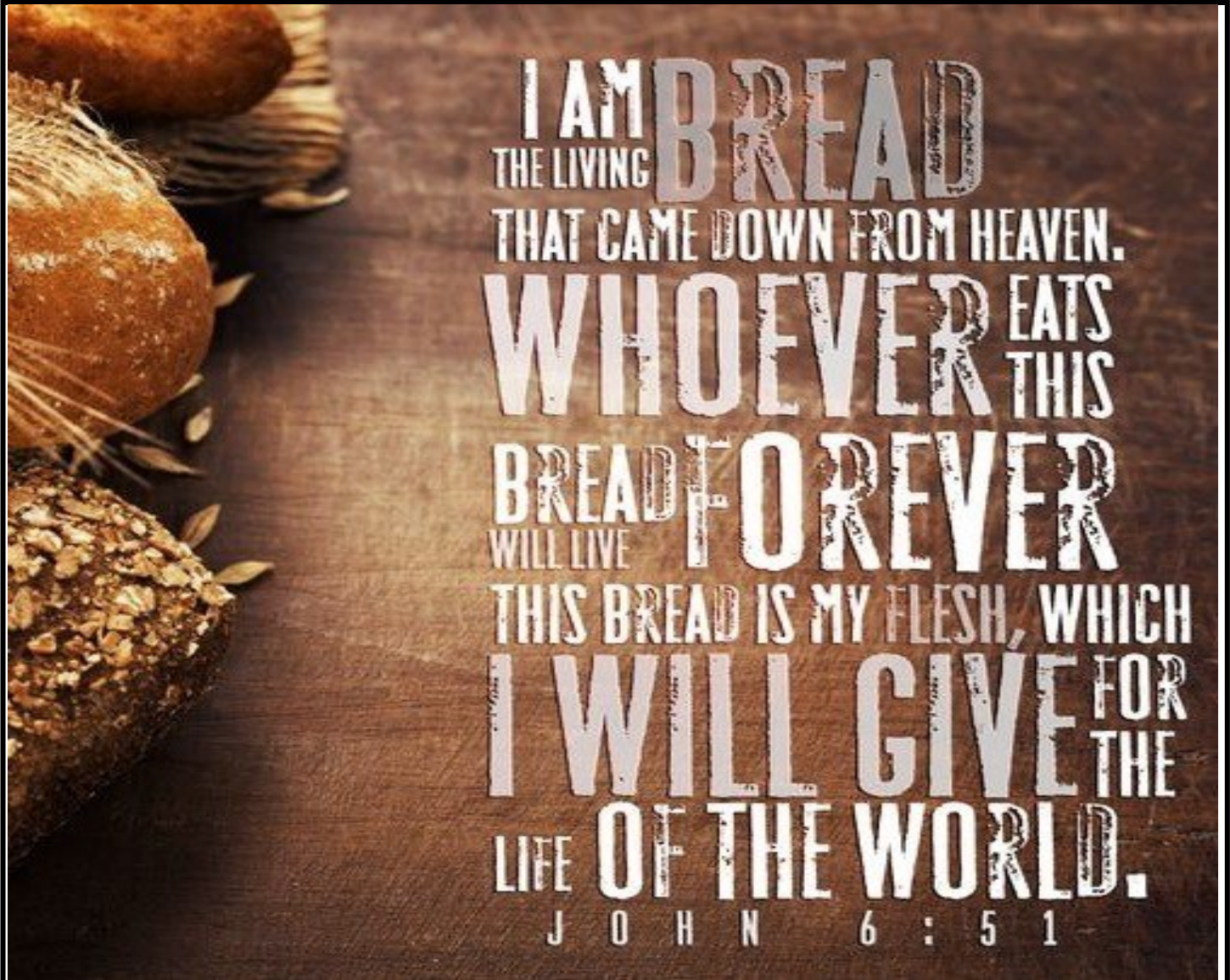

OUR DEACON JAY VANHOOSIER CELEBRATES 7 YEARS A DEACON

On Monday, August 5, Deacon Jay celebrated his 7th Anniversary as a Deacon serving in our Catholic Church. He was ordained a deacon by Archbishop Charles Thompson of the Archdiocese of Indianapolis at St. Benedict's Cathedral in Evansville IN, with 6 others from the Diocese of Evansville.

Prior to coming to the Diocese of Owensboro, where he now serves as the Director of the Office of Faith Formation, he was the Director of Religious Education at St. John the Evangelist Parish in Newburgh IN. After coming to the Diocese of Owensboro, he was asked by our previous pastor, Fr. Suneesh Mathews, if he would like to serve in his role as Deacon for us here at Precious Blood Parish, and of course we know that Deacon Jay said, "Yes!"

Here at Precious Blood Parish some of his ministering responsibilities include: preaching at the 7am Tuesday morning Mass, serving at weekend Masses and preaching one Sunday Mass a month, attending our weekly Parish Team Meeting, attending our monthly Parish Pastoral Council Meeting, serving on our newly formed Parish Leadership Team, and finally leading our OCIA (formally the RICA) process for those who want to join our Catholic Faith. This is a long list, and I may have left something out, but I believe the most important thing that he does so well for us here is smile, encourage, and accompany each of us on our road to being disciples of Jesus. For all of this I say thank you Deacon Jay for all that you do in service to Christ, Jesus. We love and appreciate you.

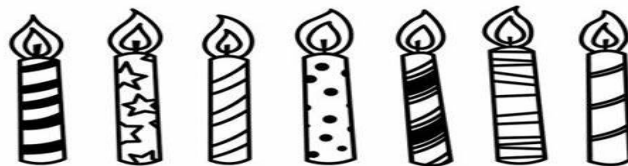
