We are excited to announce that our parish of Precious Blood has restarted our nursing home Eucharistic Ministry that was stopped during the pandemic. We will visit Davco Rest Home, Twin Rivers (formerly Bon Harbor), and Chautauqua Nursing Home. We are looking for assistance to help with this ministry. This ministry can be done during the week or on the weekend, whatever day best fit your schedule to be able to go and visit. Please prayerfully consider volunteering for this opportunity to emulate Jairus and bring Jesus to others.

You may also be interested in knowing that our Eucharistic Ministry Team goes out most every Wednesday morning from our parish to take Jesus in the Eucharist to those who cannot join us for Mass. Those that we visit are in their homes and in our city nursing and assisted living homes. We gather at 9:00am in the parish office to receive an update from our coordinator, Christine. After our update we then pray together at the Tabernacle before we leave the church. We have open spots for Eucharistic Ministers for this important ministry as well.

I often find that, in going out to take the Eucharist to those who are homebound and in our nursing homes, I am the one who is being most ministered to. It is an uplifting and encouraging ministry. I hope you will join us.

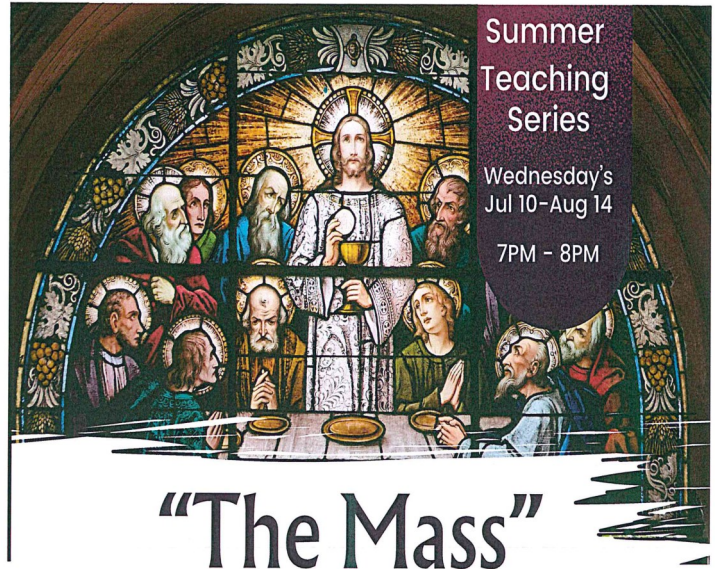
