### AN INVITATION TO TWO UPCOMING CHURCH EVENTS: OUR 64<sup>TH</sup> PARISH ANNIVERSARY & OUR FALL PARISH MISSION

This Sunday from 4pm – 6pm I would like to invite the entire parish to come and help us to celebrate our 64<sup>th</sup> Anniversary as the Parish of Precious Blood. The celebration will take place in our parish hall and on our grounds. It will include good food, a few lively games of bingo, along with games and fun for our youth.

A little piece of our history is that Bishop Cotton issued the degree for a new parish to be built here at 3306 Fenmore St. on August 25, 1960. On that same day, Fr. George Boehmicke was named the first pastor. Then on September 5, 1960 Bishop Cotton blessed the permanent church with the title of Precious Blood Church.

Something interesting to note in our history is that just 20 days later, on September 25, 1960 Bishop Cotton, who was also the first bishop of the Diocese of Owensboro, died.

I do hope that you will come and help us to celebrate the amazing parish that we are here at Precious Blood.

Another activity that I want to invite you to is our upcoming Fall Parish Mission. It is a three-night parish event, and it is taking place on September 29, 30, and October 1.

Our mission priest is Fr. Bill Garrott. Fr. Bill was born and raised in Hagerstown, Maryland and is the youngest of eight children. Fr. Bill entered the Order of Preachers (OP) in 1988 and was ordained in 1994. He has a master's degree in spiritual theology from the Angelicum in Rome. He has served as a parochial vicar, campus minister and director of vocations, and has preached over 200 parish missions throughout the United States and Canada using his powerful musical abilities. Fr. Bill is currently assigned to St. Dominic Priory in Washington, DC.

Fr. Bill will be preaching at all the Masses on the last weekend of September, the 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup>, inviting us to come and be filled with the Mercy of God. The Mission begins on Sunday evening, September 29, at 6:30pm with Fr. Bill leading the rosary, and his talk will follow from 7pm – 8pm. A complete schedule can be found on the front of this bulletin.

I hope that you can come and be with us for this uplifting and inspiring Parish Mission. Even if you can only come for one night, you will be blessed, and if you are not able to come at all, I ask that you pray for the great mission of God to work in us all.


