WHO IS OUR MISSION PRIEST FR BILL GARROTT

Fr. Bill was born and raised in Hagerstown, Maryland and is the youngest of eight children. Fr. Bill entered the Order of Preachers (OP) in 1988 and was ordained in 1994. He has a master's degree in spiritual theology from the Angelicum in Rome. He has served as a parochial vicar, campus minister and director of vocations, and has preached over 200 parish missions throughout the United States and Canada using his powerful musical abilities. Fr. Bill is currently assigned to St. Dominic Priory in Wash-

ington, DC. The Mission begins on Sunday evening, September 29, at 6:30pm with Fr. Bill leading the rosary, and his talk will follow from 7pm – 8pm. He will also offer Mass both Monday and Tuesday at 7am. There is complete mission schedule found on the front of this bulletin. Childcare is also available each evening of the Mission, however our young people and teens are especially invited to come and encounter Jesus with this Mission experience.
